- Encourage innovation in eco-friendly production methods.

4. Sustainable Logistics and Packaging

- **Packaging:** We minimize packaging and use recycled or FSC-certified materials where possible.
- **Shipping:** We optimize routes and share loads to reduce the environmental impact of deliveries.

5. Monitoring and Annual Review DIFER is committed to reviewing this policy at least annually to ensure alignment with evolving standards. We set measurable goals to drive continuous improvement in our supply chain.
